Sleeves Knit Cap to Cuff

Experience Level

Intermediate: Familiarity with SSK, K2Tog, picking up stitches, and wrap-and-turn short rows.

Class Description

Reverse your thinking on sleeves! Learn how to knit set-in sleeves from the top down and put away your sewing-up needle. Cap-to-cuff sleeves require no sewing and are always the perfect length.

You will learn:

- where to pick up stitches around the sweater armhole, and how many
- how to incorporate short rows and decreases to shape the sleeve cap
- how to use this technique with a standard sewn-in-sleeve pattern

Bring

- light-coloured DK weight yarn, or fingering if you prefer
 - DK – one 4 mm (US6), 40 cm/16” circular needle
 - Fingering – one 3.5 mm (US4), 40 cm/16” circular needle
- four locking stitch markers
- Double-points or two circulars will work, but not nearly as well**

Optional: Preclass Homework

Make and bring a sample armhole using light-coloured, smooth, DK weight yarn, and 4mm (US6) needles.

Otherwise, there will be machine-knit armholes available to borrow or buy.

Borrowers will return them after class, so you won't have your sample to take home.

Purchasers are asked to pay \$4 and will take them home.
